WHAT IS A TRANSPLANT?

A hair transplant is a surgical solution for permanent hair restoration. It involves relocating healthy hair follicles from a donor area (typically the back or sides of your scalp) to areas affected by hair thinning or baldness.

How it Works

Donor Area:

 The procedure begins with identifying a donor area, which is typically the back or sides of the scalp, where hair growth is permanent and resistant to the same hormonal changes that cause hair loss in other areas.

Hair Follicle Extraction:

 Hair follicles are carefully extracted from the donor area, either by taking a strip of skin containing follicles (Follicular Unit Transplantation or FUT) or by extracting individual follicles (Follicular Unit Extraction or FUE).

Recipient Area:

• The extracted follicles are then implanted into the recipient area, which is the area experiencing thinning or baldness.

Growth:

• The transplanted follicles will grow in their new location, mimicking the natural hair growth pattern of the donor area.



WHEN DO YOU NEED A TRANSPLANT?

A hair transplant might be considered when individuals experience permanent, patterned hair loss, such as male or female pattern baldness, or when scarring alopecia (caused by trauma, burns, or dermatological conditions) is present and fully resolved. It's also a viable option for those with specific types of non-scarring alopecia,

Here's a more detailed breakdown:

Permanent, patterned hair loss:

• Hair transplants are most commonly used for male and female pattern baldness, where hair loss follows a predictable pattern.

Scarring alopecia:

 If scarring alopecia is caused by trauma, burns, or fully resolved dermatological conditions, a hair transplant can be effective.

Non-scarring alopecia:

• Some types of non-scarring alopecia may be suitable for transplant, but surgeons generally advise against it for alopecia areata.

Age:

• While anyone over 18 can be considered, many clinics suggest waiting until at least 30 or 35, as hair loss patterns may stabilize after this age.

Hair loss stability:

 Hair transplants are typically recommended when hair loss has stopped or significantly slowed down.

General health:

 Individuals with certain health conditions, like active autoimmune diseases, uncontrolled diabetes, or allergies to local anesthesia, may not be suitable candidates.



FUE: MEDICAL PROCESS

FUE (Follicular Unit Extraction) is a precise, minimally invasive technique performed under local anaesthesia.

Step-by-Step Procedure:

• Step 1: Consultation & Planning

We assess your scalp, hair density, and future hair loss pattern. A custom plan is created, including hairline design and graft count estimation.

• Step 2: Preparation & Anaesthesia

The donor and recipient areas are trimmed and sterilised. Local anaesthetic is applied for a pain-free experience.

Step 3: Donor Hair Extraction

Individual follicular units (typically 1–4 hairs per graft) are extracted using a micro-punch tool (0.7mm-1mm in diameter). This leaves tiny, dot-like scars that are virtually undetectable.

Step 4: Graft Preservation

Extracted grafts are immediately stored in a nutrient-rich solution to ensure viability and strength.

• Step 5: Recipient Site Creation

Microscopic incisions are made in the thinning or bald areas to receive the grafts. The angle, depth, and direction are carefully planned to ensure a natural look.

• Step 6: Graft Implantation

Grafts are delicately implanted one by one. This meticulous process ensures even density and natural hair flow.

Step 7: Recovery & Growth

Mild swelling or redness subsides within days. Initial shedding occurs before new growth begins around 3–4 months post-procedure. Full results typically develop within 9–12 months.
